Details of the course:

- You don't need any previous archery experience.
- You need to be 17 years old or above.
- Duration 2 ½ days;
  - Friday 24<sup>th</sup> August, 18:00-21:00\* (*\* may over run a little*)
  - Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> August, 09:00-17:30
  - Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> August, 09:00-17:30\* (*inc a short practical assessment*)
- Venue: 1st Saltford Scout HQ, Chelwood Road, Saltford, Bristol BS31 3BU. [map](#)
- National governing body "Archery GB" award.
- Tea, coffee, fruit squash and biscuits will be provided over the 2 ½ days; however each of the attendees will need to bring their own lunch, or there are shops near.
- All archery equipment will be provided.
- What does the Archery GB Award for instructors cover?
  - Establishing and maintaining safety on a range
  - Plan and prepare a session
  - Identifying appropriate equipment for beginners to use
  - Explaining / demonstrating the simple steps to shooting barebow
  - Adapting sessions based the individual needs of participants
- Cost £180 per person. (depending on numbers)
- Outcomes of the course and renewal?
  - Upon successful completion of the course, candidates will be awarded a certificate of achievement and become an Archery GB qualified Instructor.
  - To keep the qualification valid, every three years candidates will need to complete a short renewal process. This demonstrates that you understand the minimum safety requirements for instructing archery.

The class size is limited to 12 to ensure all attendees have the necessary attention and time to practice. Places are booked on a first come first reserved basis.
