

Teaching a Practical Skill

During the Practical Skills module, you will be given the opportunity to teach a practical skill to one of the other participants. In return, you will also have the opportunity to learn a practical skill.

You may choose to teach any practical skill that you wish. It might for example be a skill used in your job or as part of a hobby or other interest. If possible, please try to avoid choosing typical 'Scouting' skills.

When deciding what skill to teach you should consider the following issues:

- You will have up to 30 minutes to teach your practical skill, with 10 minutes in which to prepare.
- You will be teaching your skill to one other participant.
- Your teaching methods should give the 'learner' the opportunity to have a go.
- You will need to bring with you to the module, any equipment, materials or other resources you require, both for your demonstration and for your learner.
